



21-STEP RV SANITIZATION GUIDE

1. Remove Trash & Leftovers

- Empty all the trash bins and make sure the fridge, cabinets, and storage areas are empty.

2. Do a proper ventilation.

- Open all windows, doors, and roof vents to eliminate the odor and bring fresh air into the interior.

3. Clean Air Filters & Vents

- Ensure the passageways where fresh air comes are clean and change air filters after prolonged usage.

4. Inspect for Pests

- Look for signs of insects or rodents and treat if necessary.

5. Strip Linens & Bedding.

- Remove all the pillowcases, blankets, towels, and sheets and wash them properly for odor and stains.

6. Wash All Fabrics.

- Check the curtains and removable upholstery covers and wash them if needed

7. Clean the Refrigerator & Freezer.

- Remove food, clean with vinegar solution, and leave open box of baking soda for odor.

8. Clean the Kitchen.

- Scrub the stovetop, microwave, sink, and counters. Always use safe cleaners to avoid food contamination.

9. Disinfect Bathroom Surfaces.

- Scrub a toilet, sink, shower, and faucets with a bleach-based or hydrogen peroxide cleaner.

10. Disinfect Bathroom Surfaces.

- Wipe the high-touch surfaces, such as doorknobs, handles, light switches, etc. with disinfectants

11. Vacuum Floors & Upholstery.

- Vacuum the floors and other surfaces to eliminate dust and debris.

12. Mop Hard Floors.

- Use disinfectant and specialized floor cleaner on kitchen and restroom floors or any vinyl, tile, or laminate flooring. Ensure the cleaning solution is hypoallergenic or safe from harsh chemicals.

13. Dust All Surfaces.

- Wipe down tables, countertops, shelves, dashboards, and vents with a microfiber cloth.

14. Shampoo Carpets (If Needed).

- If you find stains, you can do partial cleaning. Thoroughly wash using a carpet or steam cleaner for deep stains or odors.

15. Clean Mirrors & Windows.

- Use glass cleaner for a streak-free finish on mirrors and windows.

16. Exterior Wash.

- Rinse off dirt, grime, and bugs from the exterior with a pressure washer.

17. Test Appliances & Systems.

- Ensure the fridge, stove, AC, heater, and water systems work correctly.

18. Final Odor Check.

- If remnants of lousy odor exist, detect the source to address it adequately, and use air fresheners.

19. Put usage instructions.

- Specific instructions and rules should be provided, such as no smoking or deep frying. You can hang this on the wall, somewhere visible.

20. Restock Supplies.

- Refill toilet paper, soap, trash bags, cleaning supplies, and paper towels for the next renters.

21. Lock Up & Document.

- After you complete all the sanitization steps, lock up all RV doors and document everything you have done. Take post-cleaning photos to compare the RV's before-and-after condition.
